Craftsmanship+ Fostering A New And Competitive Approach To Crafts And Semi-Industrial High Added-Value Sectors is an European cofunded project whose goal is to promote new and creative businesses in traditional crafts and semi-industrial business areas anchored on high added-value production techniques.

The Crafts sector represents a high potential for:

- Economic value creation
- Job creation, in particular youth employment
- Urban, social and economic revitalization of degraded city areas

Whereas, at the same time, this sector faces challenges such as the:

- Lack of vision, entrepreneurial attitude and innovation
- Lack of craftsmen that can pass-on their knowledge and technical skills, enabling new businesses to be created
- Cost and high requirements of the apprenticeship system

Craftsmanship+ intends to develop an innovative learning solution for the younger adults entering the labour market and for the existing craftsman, and make it available to the general public.
